# LA LORENZA WALK AND KAYAK

On arrival at La Lorenza, a 15-minute walk through the forest take us to the coast, where the kayaks (double sit on top) are waiting for us. Paddling in the waters of the Parana River, the second largest in South America after the Amazon River, invite us to contemplate the forest from a different perspective and to get into its rhythm.

A swim in the river is possible as there are no aggressive animals in its waters. After 1 hour of gentle paddling, we are back on land and start an interpretive walk through the jungle with much to observe and learn: fauna-flora interconnections, medicinal plants, plant intelligence and seed dispersal strategies, lianas, fungi, mosses and lichens, endemic birds, among others.

One hour of educative walk through the forest take us to the main house where a Delicious Lunch (AM) / Early Dinner (PM) awaits us with a privileged view and a nice chat with the owners of La Lorenza.

# LA LORENZA BIRDWATCHING

On arrival at La Lorenza early in the morning we have a light breakfast. Then with bird guide, binoculars and telescope in hand we take a walk through the forest and surrounding trails in search of the most emblematic birds of the area. In La Lorenza there are about 300 species of birds. Here it is possible to sight the Golden-Crested Woodpecker, the Robust Woodpecker, Band-Tailed Manakins, different species of Tanagers and Euphonias, the Black-Breasted Plovercrest and the Red-Ruffed Fruit-Crow with its scarlet chest, among others. With a little luck and patience (increased chances during the Argentinean winter – June to August), it is possible to spot two species of toucans less popular than the Toco Toucan but of fascinating coloration, such as the Chesnut-Eared Aracari and the Spot-Billed Toucanet, the last one endemic to the Atlantic Forest. Nature offers up to us the unique chance to share in its wonders, to observe, learn about their behavior, their ecological value, and characteristics that make them unique. Led by ornithological guides specialized in the Atlantic Forest, this excursion is suitable for amateurs as well as beginners in bird watching. The visit culminates on our house with a panoramic view of the Paraná River with a delicious Lunch (AM) and a pleasant chat with the owners of La Lorenza.

In no time, you will be going out to sea. During one hour and a half, you will enjoy the interaction with Southern Right whales under the directions of the boat captain and the whale boat guide.

#### **CALAFATE**

#### **GLACIER SKY**

Taking off from El Calafate Airport, the flight offers a unique panorama of the majesty of Patagonia. Overflying the southern coast of Lake Argentino, passengers witness the impressive size of this body of water, with prominent views of Bahía Redonda and the town of El Calafate. As the plane progresses, you'll spot the Centinela River and the area of Estancia Anita, passing by Estancia Chorrillo Malo. On clear days, you can enjoy a panoramic view of the Torres del Paine in Chile, an extraordinary sight that takes your breath away. Continuing the journey, you'll traverse unique landscapes like the Rico River and Lake Roca, before marveling at the impressive distant view of the Perito Moreno Glacier. This spectacular sight is enjoyed without entering Los Glaciares National Park, ensuring the preservation of its natural beauty. The flight also offers stunning views of Cerro Buenos Aires before exploring the port of Bandera and the mystical Boca del Diablo. At this point in the flight, if the day permits, you may also be able to observe the southern face of El Chalten from a distance of approximately 80 km.

The presence of the Patagonian ranches, surrounded by pleasant landscapes, highlights the importance of the commercial and tourist development of the area. Concluding the experience, you'll fly over the beautiful Lagunas de Estancia La Unión before returning to the town of El Calafate, completing an hour of flight full of exciting landscapes and unforgettable moments.

#### ISLAND EXPERIENCE

Isla Victoria is its own universe of natural attractions. unique places and family stories. We will board a private boat to sail Nahuel Huapi's crystal clear waters for 45 minutes up to this millenary island, while overseeing Cerro López and Cerro Capilla in the surroundings of Tristeza and Blest arms and tasting our cultural Mate along the way. We disembarked at the Playa del Toro pier where the trekking starts, leading to a first mandatory stop at the cave paintings where we begin to connect with the place from another cultural point, understanding the Island as a unit beyond the white man. The journey continues to La Escuelita, the local school, a central place of attachment to local people, where we come into contact with their community and understand the importance of the different paradigms of education and contact with different world travel cultures.

From there we go down to Totoras, where we get to the other side of the island, outside the traditional circuit, arriving at the beach protected by pataguas, myrtle trees, monkey puzzle trees (male and female) and larch trees. After lunch, we return to the boat with the possibility to navigate to the bay of the sunken ship to keep track of where we were previously.

#### ANDES TRAIL GOURMET

The adventure begins by walking the oldest trekking path in Patagonia, once used by Palotino priests to reach the Cerro López refuge. This serves as a warm-up before we arrive at the Brazo Tristeza viewpoint, where, if silent, we can hear a waterfall descending from Cerro Capilla. Here, we shift into climbing mode: scrambling between boulders, helping each other, and discovering new angles of the landscape. At our first summit, we add a rock to a stone pyramid before a short trek takes us to the Lion King stone, a natural balcony overlooking Brazo Tristeza with Cerro Tronador in the background.

After a pause for contemplation and lunch, where we hear stories of the Tehuelches and their culture, we begin our descent. Along the way, we cross Gandalf Bridge and follow the Flintstones trail down to the beach. There, our kayaks await, inviting us to explore Lake Nahuel Huapi. Rowing through Nahuel Huapi to Moreno Lake, shielded by reeds and bays, we reach our endpoint, where a private transfer awaits to take us back to the hotel.

# SAN PABLO CAPE + ESTANCIA ROLITO

Every land has its secrets, but only a few are chosen to uncover them. Icons like a lighthouse on a lonely cape, a mysterious sunken ship, and a distinguished antique estancia reveal Tierra del Fuego's hidden stories. Leaving Ushuaia on National Route 3, we cross the Andes through the Garibaldi Pass at 450 meters above sea level, one of the trip's highlights. After about 60 kilometers, Lake Escondido appears amid high rocky walls. In the morning, we take Provincial Route "A" on a gravel road to Estancia Rolito. This charming ranch, with its deep-rooted sheep farming tradition, was the first to open its doors to rural tourism. Here, we pause for a delightful tea with homemade cakes, cookies, and marmalades. After enjoying this picturesque place, we head toward the Atlantic Ocean and San Pablo Cape. There, we climb to an abandoned lighthouse with a view of the Desdemona, a ship stranded for almost 40 vears, inviting us to sail back in time. Finally, we visit local fishermen Silvia and Miguel, who since 1991 have welcomed guests for a homemade lunch of fresh fish.
